

Garda Hotel San Vigilio Golf

Between the provinces of Brescia and Verona, in the countryside south of Lake Garda near the San Martino della Battaglia tower, stands the Garda Hotel San Vigilio Golf.

A course with 27 holes divided into three paths respectively Benaco, Solferino and San Martino, and the latter an additional 9- hole executive course specifically designed for novice players, and to improve the ability to play short of experienced players.

Route Starting from Championship and Gold, creating a circuit able to leverage its rich natural and historic Abbey of San Vigilio.



With 6775 meters in length when fully extended from the tee "Gold Championship of 5070 meters from the tee and the "Ladies "with other departures, the route is able to provide the utmost care to the most experienced golfer as well as the most fun for neophytes.

The water hazards, the greens well protected by bunkers strategically placed, crossprofile articulated surrounded by large rough, in addition to the variable of the possible combinations of the round of 18 holes for three different starts, are able to provide a gaming experience always different.

To complete the circuit, a large and long driving range with the possibility of dual use and then practice with the grass in the north and with 11 covered and 15 uncovered in the south front of the clubhouse.

This prestigious golf course always offers the opportunity to hire equipment, golf carts, hand trucks and electric.







Garda Golf Country Club

The Gardagolf Country Club's philosophy is to offer its Members and Guests a highly maintained technical Open championship golf course, in a breathtaking setting, and a welcoming Club House offering services par excellence.

Franciacorta Golf Club

The richness of water in this enclave of Franciacorta has been exploited by the architects Pete Dye and Marco Croze – the designers of the new Franciacorta Golf Club – who have been able to create a technically demanding course full of charm and, at the same time, "sweet" as the territory that hosts it and perfectly integrated into the surrounding natural context.





The Franciacorta Golf Club was chosen by the Italian Golf Federation already in 1989 for the organization of the National Junior Championship, which was then held here again in 1992, while in 1997 was the seat of the Italian Championship Absolute Foursome. In 1990 the Club organized its first Social Championship.

The Club has also hosted several international events: the Alpen Cup (2000 and 2006), the Internazionale Ladies d'Italia (2007), and the European Masters Senior Championship and Cup (2010)

VERONA AND ITS WINES: FROM BARDOLINO TO VALPOLICELLA

Verona is certainly the most representative Italian wine city, partly because for over 50 years it hosts the international fair of Italian wines and especially to be the Italian representative at Great Wine Capitals, the event that brings together the most representative capitals in the world of wine.

Itinerary

The excursion starts in the town of Bardolino, on the hills east of Lake Garda, with the tasting of local wines and EVO oil. The visit will take place in one of the most famous wineries and active for years in the hospitality of wine lovers from all over the world.

Not to forget the peculiar dessert wines such as Recioto della Valpolicella which is supposed to be the ancestor of Amarone, when dry wines were not in vogue. Enjoy!





BRESCIA AND ITS HISTORY

Founded over 3,200 years ago, Brescia (in antiquity Brixia) has been an important regional centre since pre-Roman times. Its old town contains the best-preserved Roman public buildings in northern Italy and numerous monuments, among these the medieval castle, the Old and New cathedral, the Renaissance Piazza della Loggia and the rationalist Piazza della Vittoria.



Vecchio: Duomo Cathedral also known as La Rotonda is circular 11th-century Romanesque church. The main structure, with rustic exteriors, was built atop ruins of an earlier basilica. Near the entrance is the pink marble sarcophagus of Berardo Maggi, while in the presbytery is the entrance to the crypt of San Filastrio. The structure houses masterworks by Alessandro Bonvicino (il Moretto); Girolamo Romanino, Palma il Giovane, Francesco Maffei, and others.

Duomo Nuovo: construction of the New Cathedral began in 1604 and only completed in 1825. Initially designed by Palladio, economic shortfalls led to a younger local architects and artists completing initial work, including decorations by Pietro Maria Bagnadore. The interior has major frescoes by Il Moretto.

Castle of Brescia: also known as Falcone d'Italia ("falcon of Italy"), locate atop Cidneo Hill at the northeast angle of the town. Built between the 13th and the 16th century and among the largest castles in Italy.







The monumental archaeological area of the Roman forum and the monastic complex of San Salvatore-Santa Giulia have become a UNESCO World Heritage Site as part of a group of seven inscribed as Longobards in Italy



Franciacorta terroir : history and passion for wine

The cultivation of vines has ancient origins on the hills of Franciacorta, as evidenced by the findings of prehistoric grape seed and the writings of classical authors such as Pliny, Columella and Virgil.

Rich archaeological material dating from prehistoric times, such as the remains of stilt house foundations found in the bogs of Sebino, reveal how primitive populations settled here and gradually took over from the Cenomani Gauls, the Romans and the Lombards.


Vine cultivation has been a constant in Franciacorta, where grapes were grown from Roman times to late antiquity and the Middle Ages, thanks to its favourable climatic and soil conditions.

Enjoy the food and wine of the area is the time to complete the quality of a holiday, whether short or long.

Each area of our country offers wines and typical foods that vary further according to the seasons, also the location in the hills gives equal access to agricultural products of the plain to the south and the mountain behind us.

Lake Iseo and Franciacorta

The perfect harmony hides in the morainic basin overlooking Lake Iseo.

It was a certain Doctor Conforti, who in 1500, defined the wines of this area as biting.

In June of 2016, the artist Christo brought his visionary concept to the lake, transforming the territory with The Floating Piers, an installation that brought millions to the small area.

When the event came to an end, the stunning landscapes and the wines they produce remained, such as the Franciacorta cultivated along the slightly inclined terraces.
