Designed at the gates of Chianti by Cecil Blandford and Peter Gannon, it hosted the Italian Open in 1983, concluded with a play-off between the legend Severiano Ballesteros, the English Ken Brown and the German Bernhard Langer, and won but he last one.

Maybe go there calmly and no matter that title, the slopes of the fairways and the scents of the Chianti forest will take you back to a very pleasant reality.










Castelfalfi Golf Club

Celebrated as one of the most difficult courses in Italy, but not less fun, Castelfalfi is the natural choice for going to the


Explore Chianti region, visit wineries and enjoy Chianti Classico wines.

I am a contributor to Sommelier Toscana magazine and I am a regional editor of the annual wine book VITAE (published by the Italian Sommelier Association). I use to taste professionally 1000 wines per year.

I also obtained the Level 3 Award in Wines of the WSET and the suitability award to become an extra-virgin olive oil taster.






Discovering FLORENCE (full day tour)

Discovering Uffizi Gallery

The Uffizi Gallery is a prominent art museum located adjacent to the Piazza della Signoria in the Historic Centre of Florence.

One of the most important Italian museums and the most visited, it is also one of the largest and best known in the world and holds a collection of priceless works, particularly from the period of the Italian Renaissance.

After the ruling House of Medici died out, their art collections were given to the city of Florence under the famous Patto di famiglia negotiated by Anna Maria Luisa, the last Medici heiress. The Uffizi is one of the first modern museums. The gallery had been open to visitors by request since the sixteenth century, and in 1765 it was officially opened to the public, formally becoming a museum in 1865.

The Uffizi Gallery has been defined the n°1 museum in the world by the famous British tourist magazine Time Out in its latest edition.



Discovering SIENA and val d'Orcia (full day tour)

At dawn in Siena, the golden reflection of the sun spreads through the narrow streets and majestic palaces surrounding the famous Piazza del Campo. The fresh air is infused with the scent of coffee from the ancient cafes, while the sound of footsteps echoes through the alleyways, heralding the beginning of an extraordinary day.
